Theme

Justification by .....

Historical Background

- 1 Paul founded the churches in Galatia during the .....missionary journey (Acts 13-14; Map 254).
- 2 After leaving the area, apparently some .....Christians arrived and they accused Paul of omitting crucial parts of the gospel, and they insisted that Galatians needed to submit to Jewish law and custom (such as circumcision) in order to be truly Christian.
- 3 Although Paul was willing to accommodate Jewish .....(Acts 16:3), he vehemently opposed this as a requirement.
- 4 This letter is ringing a declaration that .....is God's free gift, and a hard-hitting rejection of any hint that it must somehow be earned.

Characteristics

- 1 Paul's passion for Christ and the gospel are evident in his anger and surprise at the Galatians' acceptance of the ..... (1.6-9; 3.1; 5.12).
- 2 Galatians is like a rough version of Romans because arguments for justification by faith are carefully developed and logically in Romans, whereas Galatians is an ..... response to a challenge that Paul felt very deeply.
